SLEEPOVER CHECKLIST

A checklist to help parents and caregivers consider hazards and make decisions about sleepovers, and slumber parties.

Before you say "yes"

<input type="checkbox"/>	How well do you know the home ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Is the home clean ? Does it appear to be structurally sound ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Is the home in a safe area ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Is your child comfortable in the home and with all the occupants ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Are you comfortable leaving your child in the home overnight ?

How well do you know the parent(s) ?

<input type="checkbox"/>	Are they mature, responsible and conscientious ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Will they supervise the children throughout the stay ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Will they remain sober and attentive ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Are they cautious with candles, lighters, matches, and smoking materials.

Ask the parents

<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there working smoke detectors on every level, throughout their home ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Is there at least one carbon monoxide detector in the home ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Do they have a fire escape plan that includes two ways out ? (your child should know their plan and be present when the family conducts a fire escape plan drill)
<input type="checkbox"/>	The home where the sleep over is the parents should walk all of the children through the escape plan ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask where is the location of their meeting place ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Where will your child be sleeping ? (Is there a smoke detector in that room)
<input type="checkbox"/>	Do the parents prohibit candles in the bedrooms ?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Write where the family meeting place is :
